Programs

BHS fits the profile of a school devoted to student success. Our school offers different academic programs which lead to a Diploma of Secondary Studies (DES).

+ Enriched Francais Plus

This program is designed for students whose primary language is French and are highly motivated learners who have the ability to work at an accelerated pace.

+ Enriched

This program is designed for students who are highly motivated and independent learners who have the ability to work at an accelerated pace.

+ Immersion

This program is intended for students who have followed a French Immersion elementary program or are coming from the French elementary school system in Quebec.

+ Core

This program is intended for students who have followed an English or bi-lingual elementary school program.

+ In-School Alternatives

We offer multiple in-school alternative programs which are designed to meet the specific needs of our diverse student body including: Embarkations (Sec 4-5), Core Plus (Sec 3), Literacy (Sec 2), and many other supports offered through the Resource Department.
