#### **First Days of School**








#### First Day of School (August 29th) Grade 7 only

- BBQ in the courtyard for lunch (free)













#### A Student's Day 1 Schedule







(This is a supply list of items to purchase.)

Note 1: The links lead to examples, but any brand is acceptable.

Note 2: Binder colours are recommended, but not mandatory. The colour system is designed

to help with organization.

Note 3: Some teachers <u>may</u> request additional supplies. Note 4: Label supplies with the student's first & last name.

Note 5: Supplies may need to be replenished, especially pencils.

GENERAL COURSE MATERIALS	<b>Estimated Cost</b>	/
One laptop (Chromebook & Macbook have the least connectivity issues)  - Device should be less than 3 years old  - Please label the outside cover of the device		
One set of <u>inexpensive earbud headphones</u> (To be kept in the pencil case, preferably in a container or plastic bag.)	\$12.00	
Combination Lock (main locker) - Practice opening lock before the first day of school!	\$7.00-\$10.00	
Pencil case including 2 pens, 1 red pen, 2 pencils, 2-4 highlighters of assorted colours, pencil sharpener (closed container), and 1 eraser, 1 ruler	\$10.00	
Coloured Pencils (one package of 24 pencils)	\$4.50	







#### **Laptops at BHS**

Teachers may use combination of pencil-to-paper work, as well as work that can be done using the devices. Laptops *might* be used **if they increase at least one** of the following:

- Engagement
- Comprehension
- Speed of work
- Organization
- Ability to assess learning



In classes like math, for example, even if work is "online", students must still practice showing proper procedures on paper. Just because a question is "online", doesn't mean that solutions shouldn't be written down.





#### **Laptops - Types of Devices**

- **Chromebooks are highly recommended**. LBPSB uses Google App, so Chromebooks work seamlessly.





- MacBooks and Windows laptops are also used by our students.
- Tablets are not recommended.



## **Laptop Recommendations**

- Label the device and the charger.
- Charge overnight and send a charger to school.
- A **protective case** is recommended.
- Create two profiles: One for personal use and one for school use.
- Students must log in to their @lbpearson account at school



- Don't share passwords



- Please give your child **administrative access** to the computer so they may download applications to their device without parental permission.





#### **Google Classroom**



 Most BHS teachers will use Google Classroom to post important dates and materials.

Google Classroom

- As parents, you can sign up for a "Parent account" so you can receive daily or weekly summaries but you cannot view grades.

- Better yet, have your child log into their account and get full access along with grades.



#### **BHS Cell Phone Policy**

- Cell phones and instant messaging on laptops are only permitted during the following:
  - Before/After school, Recess and Lunch
- Cell phones should remain **OFF** and in the student's locker during class.
- Please do not expect your child to respond to your texts during class time.
- Scaffolded consequences if caught using cell phones / instant messaging during class time.

  - Two or three other ordering periods done throughout school year.








- Make new friends

- Attend field trips; they are part of the curriculum and students have lots of fun and make lots of memories








# Step 1: Sign in to Mozik and select your child







#### **Step 2: Click on Resources button**








# Step 3 + 4: Click on 'School Board' tab and




# Step 5: Select your child (only if you have multiple children)








# Step 5: Click on 'Media Release Permission'
