Once again, the Students of Beaconsfield High School are organizing our annual Terry Fox Run. This year's run/walk is scheduled for Wednesday, September 25, 2024 (Rain Date September 26). We will be celebrating **Beaconsfield High School's 44th run. Beaconsfield High School is proud to have participated in every Terry Fox Run to date, and to have raised over \$455,000 over the past 43 years.**

We will have donations boxes set up at the Cycle 1 and 2 offices as well for those who would like to donate cash. We will not be collecting paper pledge forms. Cash donations will remain anonymous and no tax receipts will be given.

All students at BHS participate in the run/walk. All students will meet at the front of the school at 12:00 and begin the run shortly after. Upon returning to the school, they will have the opportunity to buy a BBQ lunch, hosted by the Student Life Team.
