GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS





- 54 Credits in total from Grade 10 & 11+20 credits must be earned at the Grade 11 level
- Required Courses Grade 10:
- Must pass EVERYTHING from Grade 10
- No more back-crediting, Summer School only
- Required Courses Grade 11:
 Grade 11 English Grade 11 Ethics and/or PE
 Grade 11 French
- +20 remaining credits from Grade 11 level



IMPORTANT MEES update

MEES is phasing out "Back-Crediting" After this year graduating Cohort.







CEGEP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

3 Year Career Programs

2 Year Pre-University Programs


Prepare students for the world of work.

- Develop marketable knowledge and skills
- Often include stage/internship
- Lead to real jobs/certification
- Student can still go on to university (may need to take additional pre-requisites for c hosen university program.
- Some university programs offer advanced standing to graduates of 3-year CEGEP programs.

e.g. Police Technology, Respiratory and Anesthesia Technology, Special Care Counselling, Business Administration, Computer Science, Dental Hygiene etc. Prepares students for university studies.

- Theoretical rather than "hands-on"
- Include university pre-requisites in the program.
- Limited practical value IF the student does not attend university -
- Does not develop the skills or competencies to obtain a career in that field without further study.

e.g. Social Sciences, Liberal Arts, Commerce, Pure and Applied Sciences, Health Sciences, Music, Creative Arts, Languages, and Literature etc.

You can always **switch** programs!

If really unsure, take a more "general program"



- Final Grade 10 marks
- O Term I & II of Grade 11
- 068% or Higher English
- 065% or Higher French
- O Sending letters to CEGEP electronically



- O Sciences: 85%-90% (depending on CEGEP) or higher & 80s in Chem, Phys, Math
- Social Sciences: 75% or higher
- o Arts, Literature and Languages: 75% or higher
- Liberal Arts: 78-80% or higher
- Visual Arts: 75% or higher **PORTFOLIO
- O Career Programs: BIG variety in marks

- O Cost: 30-35\$ VISA/MASTERCARD

Can upload personal Letters to online applications


Nothing for you to do now, but work hard and attend Open houses!




- O Pre-Requisites: Grade 9 & 10 French, English, Math OR High School Diploma
