### **Re: Influenza A (H1N1) Vaccination Bussing – December 1<sup>st</sup>**

Dear Parents :

Last week you received an information letter and consent form concerning the H1N1 influenza vaccination campaign for children in primary and secondary schools in the region. Details of the procedures for bussing for the vaccination program were formalized over this past weekend.

Students of Beaconsfield High, who have returned their consent forms, will be transported by school bus on Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup> to the vaccination centre located at Allancroft School at 265 Allancroft Road in Beaconsfield. The time period we have been assigned is 10:00AM to 12:35PM. Supervised busses will be leaving the school on a rotating basis beginning at 10:00 AM. Mrs. Messina (Cycle 1 Vice Principal) and I will be at the vaccination centre for the duration of the designated time period ensuring that your son or daughter feels safe and looked after. Mr. Rabinovitch (Cycle 2 Vice Principal) will remain at BHS to oversee the loading of the busses.

### **Important Information:**

1. Your child should wear a short-sleeved top. (It can be underneath a “hoodie” which they will remove for the vaccination)
2. If a reaction occurs at the centre, you will be contacted immediately.
3. It is not necessary to send your child’s medicare card or vaccination record.
4. Your child will bring the stamped vaccination form home for your records.
5. If your child is absent tomorrow, December 1<sup>st</sup> you will need to take them to the vaccination centre at a later date.

I take this opportunity to thank you for your cooperation in assisting the Québec Ministry of Public Health to carry out this endeavor in a safe and effective manner. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school at 514-697-7220.
