

# Evaluation for 2019-2020 based on the directives from the Ministry of Education and Higher Education

Please see the breakdown of how high school grades will be calculated. Note: The last report card will be issued by July 10, 2020.

### Secondary I to secondary III students

Term 1: weighted at 40% Term 2: Weighted at 60%

Term 3: Pass, Fail or Not evaluated

## **Final Result: Pass, Fail** for each subject based on:

-First 2 terms

-Evaluations done before March 13

-Observations done before or after that date

#### **Secondary IV and V students**

Term 1: weighted at 40% (marks represented as percentages)

Term 2: weighted at 60% (marks represented as percentages)

Term 3: Pass, Fail or not evaluated

**Important:** Term 3 Pass, Fail or Not evaluated are based on:

-Evaluations done before March 13 and observations done before and after that date

# Final Result: The final subject mark indicated on the report card will be in percentages and given by competency.

The interruption of education and teaching services should not significantly deviate the trajectory on which the student was on. If the student was on the path to success in the first two terms, he or she should receive "Pass" as a final mark.

Observations recorded after March 13 could change the final mark. For example, if a student was failing in the first terms, but has demonstrated his or her competency in work completed after March 13, he or she may receive a Pass mark in the final result.

The Pass decisions will be taken by the school team based on the student's final report card.
