A Starter Supply Kit will be available from [School Start](#). You also have the option to purchase items individually. (This service is offered by the BHS Home & School Association.)

Please note:

1. The links lead to examples, but **any brand** is acceptable.
2. **Binder colours** are recommended, but optional. The colour system is designed to help with organization.
3. Some teachers may request additional supplies.
4. **Label** supplies with the student's first and last name (including the laptop and charger).
5. Supplies may need to be replenished, especially pencils.
6. **Combination locks** for the student lockers are **issued by BHS** (Included in consumable fees.)
7. *Physical Education combination locks can be purchased at BHS or elsewhere.*

Laptops at BHS

Teachers may use combination of pencil-to-paper work, as well as work that can be done using the devices. Laptops *might* be used **if they increase at least one** of the following:

- **Engagement**
- **Comprehension**
- **Speed of work**
- **Organization**
- **Ability to assess learning**



In classes like math, for example, even if work is “online”, students must still practice showing proper procedures on paper. Just because a question is “online”, doesn’t mean that solutions shouldn’t be written down.



Laptops - Types of Devices

- **Chromebooks are highly recommended.** LBPSB uses Google App, so Chromebooks work seamlessly.

- MacBooks and Windows laptops are also used by our students but less recommended.
- Tablets (such as iPads) are **not** recommended.



Laptop Recommendations

- **Label** the **device** and the **charger**.
- **Charge overnight** and **send a charger to school**.
- A **protective case** is recommended.
- Create **two profiles**: One for personal use and one for school use.
- Students must log in to their @lbpearson account at school 
- **Don't share passwords** 
- Please give your child **administrative access** to the computer so they may download applications to their device without parental permission.

- Most BHS teachers will use Google Classroom to post important dates and materials.
- As parents, you can sign up for a “**Parent account**” so you can receive daily or weekly summaries but you cannot view grades.

- Better yet, have your child log into their account and get full access along with grades.










Step 1: Sign in to Mozik and select your child






Step 2: Click on Resources button






Step 3 + 4: Click on 'School Board' tab and then 'Media release' link






Step 5: Select your child (only if you have multiple children)






Step 5: Click on 'Media Release Permission'

BHS Cell Phone Policy (Code of Respect)

Cell phones must stay at home or in a student's locker during the academic hours of a school day.

This includes any period of time between 9:05 and 3:35, including recess and lunch.

CONSEQUENCES

- 1st offence: -verbal warning and teacher holds on to phone for the class
- 2nd offence: -phone will be checked in at the main office for a period of **one full school day**.
- 3rd offence: -phone will be checked in at the main office for a period of **five full school days**.
- 4th offence: -a meeting with parents and administration.

- Attend field trips: they are part of the curriculum and students have fun and make wonderful of memories




